Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome back to the new term. I hope all our families had a restful and enjoyable summer break.

It has been an interesting start to the term due to national events. A change of Prime Minister and Head of State in the same week must be unheard of in our history. The sad news yesterday of the death of Queen Elizabeth II will have an impact on the country and schools over the coming weeks. I will write again once details of any school closures for the Queen's funeral are announced. In regards to school we will hold special assemblies to mark this. Our local church, St Mary's on Church Lane, has also opened a book of condolence. Should any parent want their child to contribute to this and let them be part of such an historic event please let us know and we can easily pop down with them during the school day.

Student Numbers

As you are aware Wexham is a growing school. The school now has more students on roll than at anytime in its history. Whilst growth has been seen over the last few years from incoming Year 7 groups, I am exceptionally pleased to see that growth is also happening in our Sixth Form. Last year we enrolled the largest Year 12 cohort for many years, this has been beaten this year. In particular we have begun to appeal more broadly to a large number of external students wishing to continue their studies with us. As such I am pleased to say our recruitment for new staff was exceptionally strong last term. However, amongst some of the new staff I announced in my letter in July are two key appointments for the school. Mrs Bahra is our new Leader of Year 7 and Mrs Sheehan our new Leader of Year 10.

Results

Whilst our A Level and GCSE results remain provisional until October, I am pleased that our A Level results were considerably better than in 2019 and our GCSE results at the moment on par with 2019, but should rise. Our 2019 GCSE results were a strong set of results for the school. National comparisons are being made to 2019, the last year when students sat formal examination. Given so much disruption over the last few years I am incredibly proud of the effort and dedication our students put in. Parag Bassi deserves a special mention for achieving A* A* A in his A Level results.

School Uniform

Our students have returned this week in very smart uniform. Thank you. Over the summer a lot of media attention focused on school uniform. Please do rest assured that we have sourced the best for value uniform and is now available from two suppliers. If parents are facing genuine difficulties, please do contact your child's Leader of Year and we may be able to offer support. I would also be interested in old/outgrown useable blazers, jumpers and sports kits to be donated back to the school so we can reuse them where we can.
