Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome to the Spring Term and the new year. I hope all parents and students had a lovely holiday period.

Planned strike action by the National Education Union

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union (NEU) has declared strike action, which is currently planned to take place on the following dates.

- Wednesday 1st February 2023
- Thursday 2nd March 2023
- Wednesday 15th March 2023
- Thursday 16th March 2023

The strikes are happening because of a national dispute between the NEU and the Government over teachers' pay, their loss of earnings over the last 11 years and the impact of funding on schools generally. The Government is engaging in talks with the NEU so hopefully a resolution can be found which will mean any strike action will be cancelled.

I am contacting you at this point to give you as much notice as possible about our arrangements and so that you can take the necessary action for your child if or when it may be required.

in line with the Department for Education's advice should we need to either fully or partially close, we will apply the principles set out in the DfE's emergency planning and response guidance by giving priority to vulnerable children, children of critical workers and then, if possible, those sitting public examinations this summer.

However, members of the NEU are not required to let us know in advance whether they intend to be away from school on the planned days of strike action. This means until the day of the strikes, I will not know for certain whether we will be able to run the school as we normally would. It means the above guidance from the DfE is difficult to implement. I must assess the risk based on the number of teachers present in school to the number of students. This will be challenging to do without prior notice and therefore I will have to make a judgement in advance. Therefore, please plan to keep your children at home on this day unless I inform you differently. Teaching staff are not allowed to cover striking colleagues. Striking staff will not set work for students to do in their absence.

The DfE have changed the rules so it is now possible for employers to engage with agency staff to replace the work of those taking official strike action. However, I need to stress that the availability of agency teaching supply staff is scarce at the best of times and I would imagine near impossible to obtain on strike days.

Students that we ask to remain home on these days will be set work to complete via 'Show My Homework' if their teachers are not striking. Students in school may not necessarily be able to follow their normal curriculum. Students at home will not have access to online teaching from teaching staff as this takes considerable time to set up and without knowing which staff will be on strike or not on any given day extremely difficult to arrange. In addition to teacher setting work on 'Show My Homework' our website has a lot of additional learning available, follow the Curriculum tab and then Home Learning and then to each relevant year group.

I apologise that you may have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice, and that they may experience further disruption to their education but I hope that in communicating the uncertainty of the situation at this stage this will enable you to make arrangements.

I will inform you as soon as possible if or when I know further details and hope that a resolution can be reached between the NEU and the Government as quickly as possible.
