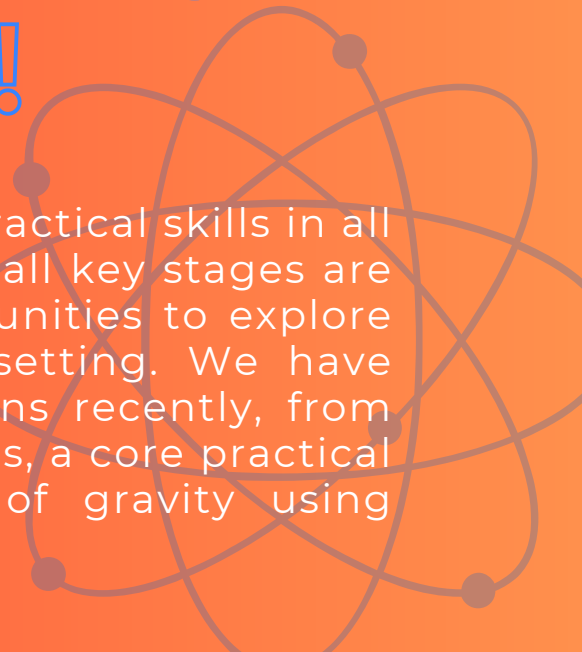

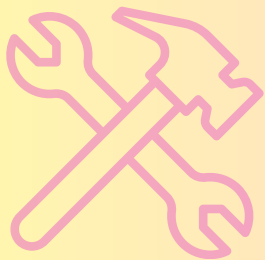


Year 11 STEM

Year 7 Bedrock Champions!

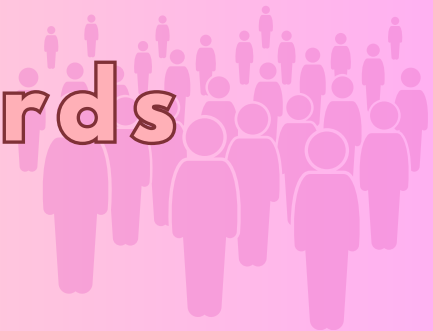
