Dear Parent/Carer

The school has had a very successful term. Thank you for all the continuing support you provide for your children in their learning and helping us to ensure they enjoy and achieve.

Last Day of Term / Start of New Term

Friday 20th December is the last day of the Autumn Term. The school will operate its customary compact day and will close at 1pm. Student that are normally collected from school must be collected promptly. The school will reopen to all students on Tuesday 7th January 2025 at the normal time.

Free School Meals

The government has provided additional funding to local authorities to support students on Free School Meals over the holidays. This will follow the same format as previous vouchers and will be emailed to those parents it concerns.

Non-Uniform Day

The school will be holding a non-uniform day on Wednesday 18th December. Proceeds will be split between Save the Children's Christmas Jumper Appeal and ICRC (International Red Cross and Red Crescent) appeal for humanitarian aid in Gaza.

Students wishing to take part and wear non uniform to school must bring £1. There is of course no charge for students attending in full school uniform.

Thank you for all your donations on our last non-uniform day which raised £1200 for Children in Need.

Governing Board

I am pleased to announce the school has a new Chair of Governors, Alison Hibbert. Alison joined the board in the summer and is also our Local Authority Governor. Alison is a former teacher and currently works in a senior position in the local authority. She knows and understands the school and its wider work well having also been a board member of the Slough School's Sports Partnership for many years.

Parent Governor Vacancies

Start of the School Day

The school day starts at 8.40am. Students should be onsite before this time. Being punctual means the day starts positive. The most common reason given for lateness is traffic problems. I urge you, wherever possible, to encourage your child walk or cycle to school. This will help them be healthier, improve our environment and reduce traffic problems. Students should not be on site before 8am. Can I also remind some of our parents that do drive to school NOT to block local residents' driveways and please do not park on pavements, cycle lanes and grass verges.

Attendance

Regular school attendance is crucial for your child's educational progress and success. It not only allows them to fully engage in the learning process but also fosters a sense of routine and responsibility that will benefit them in the long run. At Wexham, an attendance rate of 95% and above is considered acceptable.

What you can do to help:

- Avoid scheduling holidays when school is in session. They are considered unauthorised absences and will result in a fine.
- Build regular routines for bedtime and the morning.
- Avoid medical appointments when school is in session.

We want to ensure that all our students have the best possible educational experience, and this can only be achieved through regular attendance and a commitment to following government guidelines.

If you anticipate any absences due to exceptional circumstances, please contact the school in advance to discuss your situation. We will do our best to work with you to minimise any impact on your child's education.

Emergency Closure

A reminder of our emergency closure procedure.

- The decision to close the school outside of core hours will be taken by 7.30am after an assessment of poor weather conditions or on the advice of Slough Borough Council or the emergency services. We will always aim to contact parents by text message as early as possible; normally this would be by 7.45am, before students leave for school. Messages will also be displayed on the school website.
- Should the school be forced to close during the day, or your child has arrived on school premises in the morning, you will be contacted before we send student's home.
- Further text messages and our website will update parents of our situation. For this reason, it is always vital that the school has up to date contact details.
