We look forward to continuing to support great causes like this one and making a difference in our community.



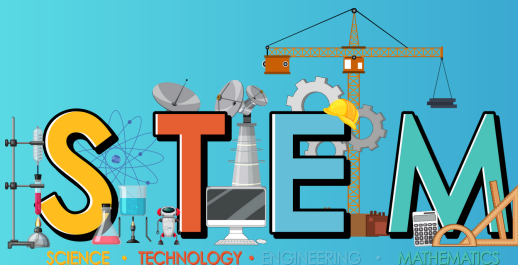
Inspiring the Next Generation: STEM Talk for Sixth Form Girls

Year 11 Sixth Form Taster Day: A Glimpse Into the Future

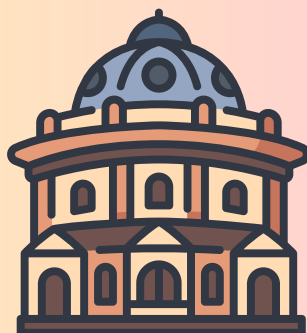


Year 11 students at Wexham School had an exciting day as they stepped into the world of Sixth Form during our Sixth Form Taster Day!
