WEXHAM SCHOOL POLITICS STUDENTS VISIT THE HEART OF DEMOCRACY

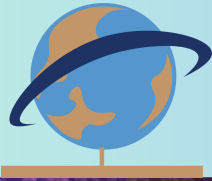
Wexham School KS5 Politics students had the incredible opportunity to visit the Houses of Parliament, experiencing first-hand the inner workings of British democracy.

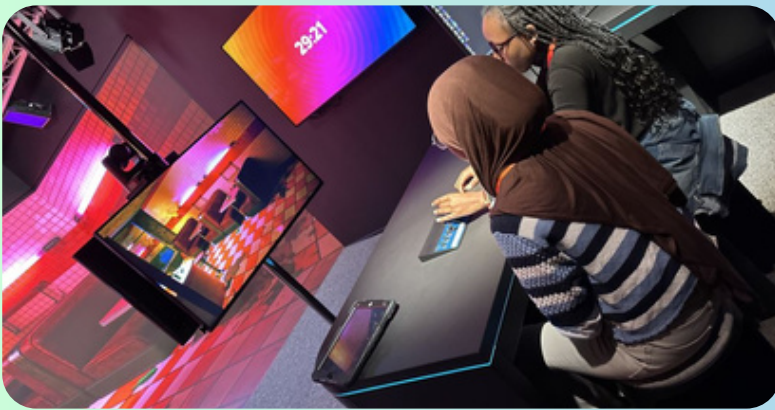
This visit was a truly eye-opening experience, sparking even greater enthusiasm for politics among our students. Many of them highly recommend the trip to anyone interested in how our country is run.

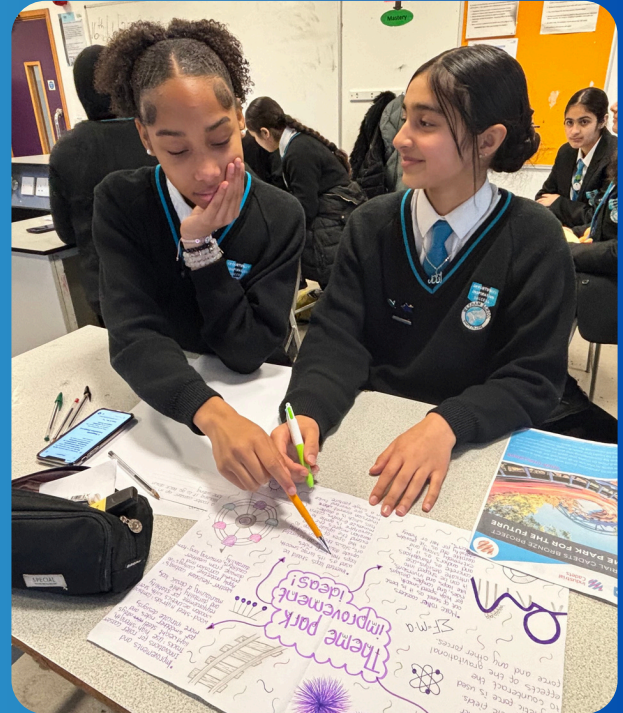
Year 9 Engineering Development Trust STEAM Workshop

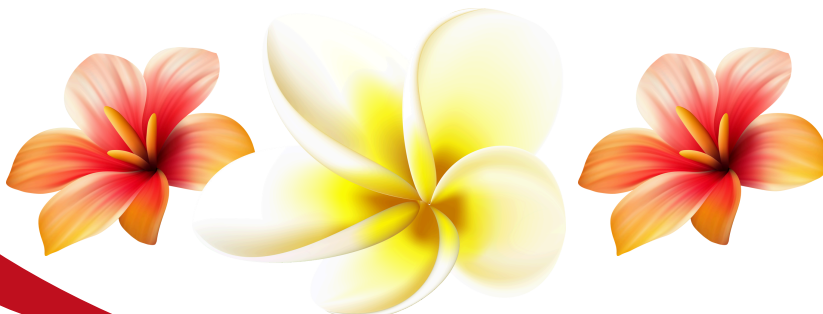
Team Thailand Day 1: Exploring Thai Culture

It was a day filled with learning, culture, and new experiences! Stay tuned for more updates as our journey continues.

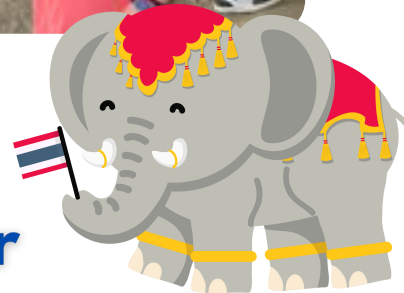

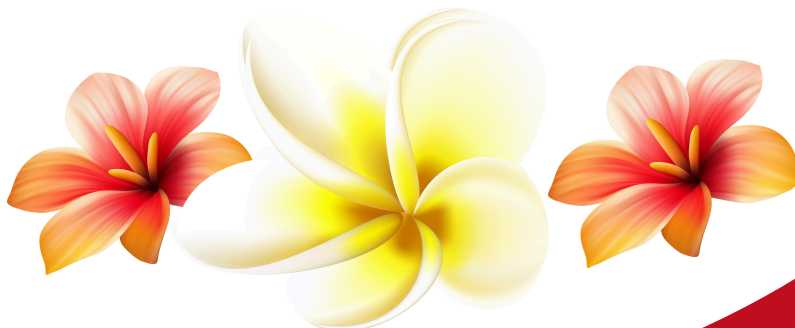
Team Thailand Visits Elephant Sanctuary: A Day to Remember

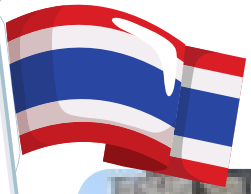
