TED Talks

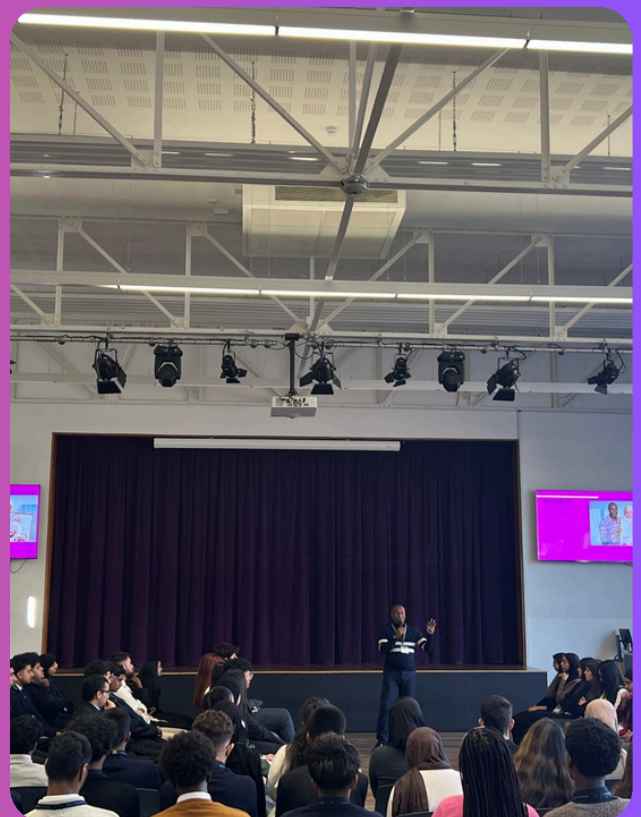

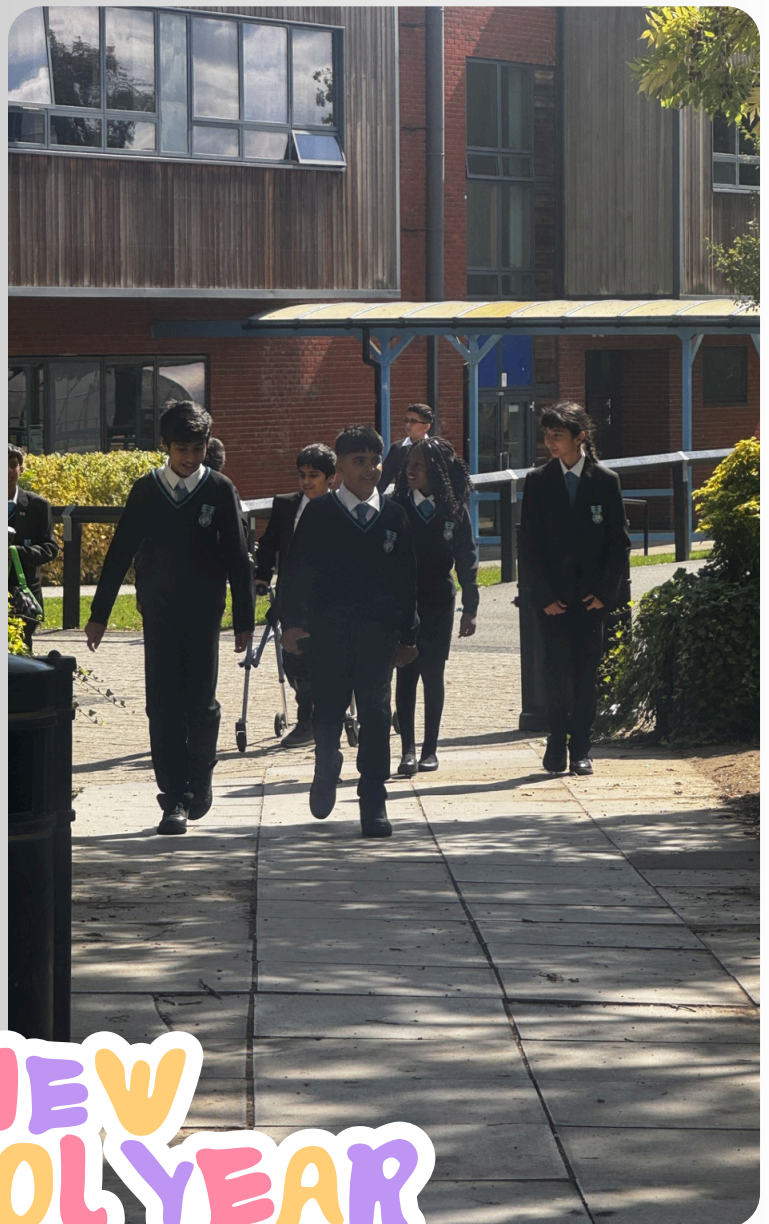
A New Beginning: Year 7 Settle into Life at Wexham School

Exploring Coastal Processes: Geography

Field Trip to Milford-on-Sea



Our Year 11 and Year 13 Geography students recently took part in an exciting and educational field trip to Milford-on-Sea, a beautiful coastal location in Hampshire known for its stunning views, rich biodiversity, and dynamic coastal landforms. The trip provided a fantastic opportunity for students to apply their classroom learning to a real-world setting, deepening their understanding of coastal processes and management strategies.



Throughout the day, students carried out a range of coastal fieldwork investigations, focusing on how natural forces shape the coastline and how human intervention can help manage change. Key activities included:

- Measuring groynes to assess sediment build-up and evaluate the effectiveness of coastal management techniques.
- Conducting wave counts to determine whether the waves were constructive or destructive, and how this influences erosion and deposition.
- Measuring longshore drift to identify the direction of sediment movement along the coastline — a key process in coastal geography.
- Interviewing local residents to gain insight into community perspectives on tourism, coastal facilities, and local development.

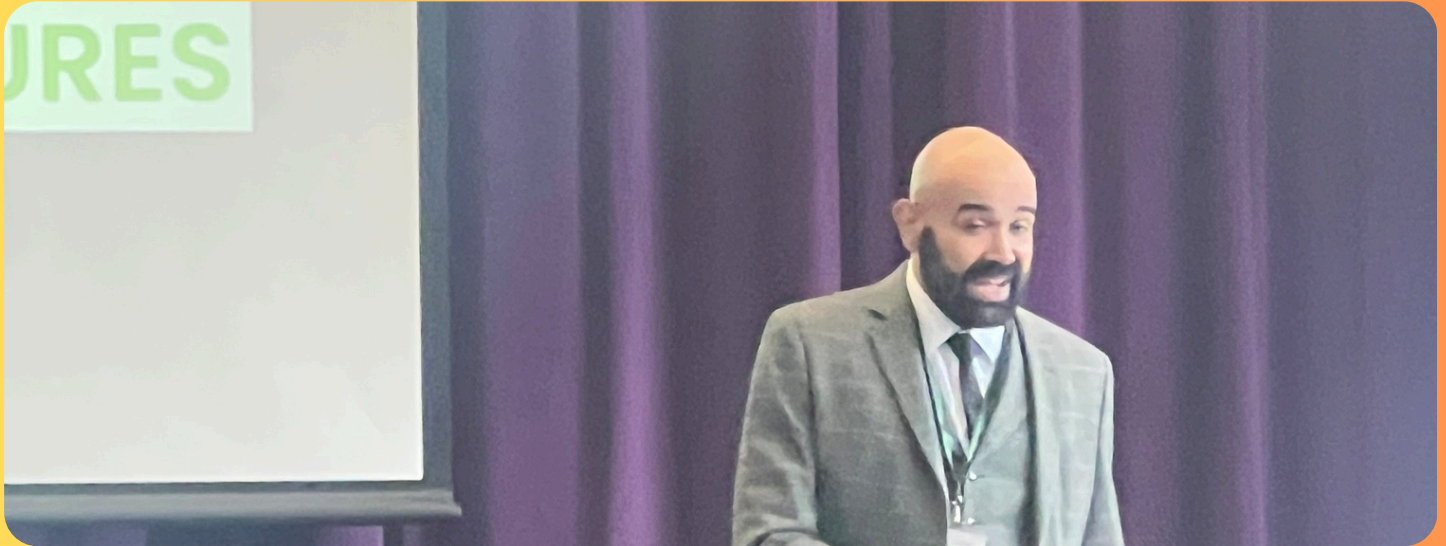
The day ended with a well deserved lunch on the beach, where students relaxed, enjoyed the warm weather, and reflected on everything they had learned.

The event was a wonderful reminder of the importance of staying active, and the photos captured some truly memorable moments from the day.

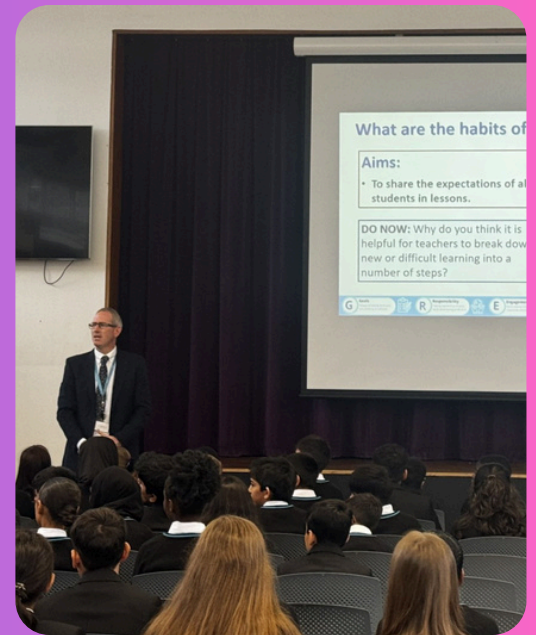
