## Year 11 & Year 13 Easter Interventions

Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to share the offer of **subject interventions during the Easter break**. The school will be open on **Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of the first week** offering additional subject support in a very wide range of subjects including English, Maths and Science. *Sessions are open to all students.*

**The final GCSE and A-Level exams start from the 5<sup>th</sup> of May (GCSE) and the 11<sup>th</sup> May (A-Levels).** After Easter your child will receive their exam timetable. Some important reminders for parents about final exams:

- *The dates and times for final GCSE and A-Level exams are externally set by the exam boards.*
- *The final exams cannot be rescheduled or delayed for any reason.*
- *Every child must attend school to sit the exams on their exam timetable.*
- *Students who do not attend receive an 'X' in that exam from the exam boards.*

**For your child to revise successfully over Easter we recommend they have:**

- A quiet space (or time) of their own to study.
- Flash cards to create key vocabulary, definitions, diagrams or knowledge tests.
- A revision timetable or plan of what key knowledge, topics and exam skills they need to revisit.
