## Spring Term Subject Clinics & Exam Study Leave

We are delighted to announce that GCSE and A-Level Subject Clinics will re-commence from **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April for all students in Year 11 and Year 13.**

I write to **enclose our full Subject Clinic Schedule below this letter** with clinics held before school, during lunchtime and after the usual school day.

**Subject Clinics intend to address and target any gaps in knowledge or exam technique which we have identified for improvement from the Year 11 and Year 13 PPEs (pre-public-exams) in March.** Each session has been specifically designed to focus on and close these gaps and it would be extremely advantageous for your child to attend as often and as many of these sessions as possible.

Subject Clinics involve additional teaching and learning time as part of smaller groups of students, led by our most experienced members of staff; extra learning and access to subject experts makes a significant difference to student outcomes in the summer exams.

We have made students aware that these are drop-in sessions, and they have the freedom to make their own decisions about which they wish to attend each week. However, a few students will be targeted to attend specific subjects and will receive further communication on this matter in due course.

**Study Leave:** All Year 11 and 13 students are expected to **attend school as normal until 22<sup>nd</sup> May.** After this time students are welcome to study from home as they wish and attend only for their final exams. The school will remain open for those that wish to follow their normal timetable, teachers will continue to deliver revision lessons.
