

KS3 ART

Intent

To enable and develop students who:

- build and develop confidence in themselves and working with others
- can communicate and develop their ideas effectively
- contribute to teams and collaborate well with other students
- understand the historical and cultural development of art forms
- produce creative work, explore their ideas and record their experiences

Skills

The core skills students will develop are:

- the ability to create purposeful and meaningful artwork
- the ability to analyse and evaluate their own work and the work of others
- proficiency in drawing, painting, sculpture, and design
- the ability to use a broad range of art techniques and mediums
- how to create and communicate an idea, through developing, refining and amending work as it progresses
- how meaning is communicated and interpreted through art

Knowledge

The core knowledge students will develop is:

- understanding of a range of artists and cultures
- how to use a range of techniques to record observations and explore ideas
- understanding the elements of art and how to apply them in their own work
- how to use appropriate vocabulary and subject-specific terminology when analysing and evaluating their own work and that of others

GCSE ART

Intent

To enable students to:

- actively engage in the creative process of art and design
- develop critical understanding through investigative and analytical skills
- become confident in taking risks and learn from experiences when exploring and experimenting with ideas, processes, and media.
- develop technical skills through working with a broad range of media, materials, and techniques
- reflect on and evaluate their own work and that of others
- develop an awareness and understanding of a range of art styles and movements
- adopt safe working practices in art and design

Skills

The core skills students will develop are:

- Develop ideas through investigations informed by selecting and critically understanding sources
- Explore a range of techniques, media, and processes
- Record ideas, observations, and insights both visually and through written annotation using specialist vocabulary
- the ability to critically analyse and evaluate their own work and the work of others
- Use drawing skills for different needs and purposes
- the ability to understand how professional art works can be interpreted and used as a source of inspiration
- the ability to refine ideas as work progresses and use visual language to communicate an idea or theme

Knowledge

The core knowledge students will develop is:

- Understanding the unique qualities of different materials and processes and being able to exploit these within practical work.
- Understanding of the work and approaches of artists and designers from a range of periods, societies, and cultures
- Make connections between art movements and historical/cultural events.
- Explore key Art pieces and develop skills in analysing and expressing opinions using artistic terminology and vocabulary.
- appropriate vocabulary and subject-specific terminology
- Understand how sources inspire the development of ideas and use these to realise intentions
